Four Stitching Modes

Let the machine regulate your stitch length or keep your machine at a constant speed. The Vision 2.0 includes four standard stitching modes: stitch regulate, coast regulate (controls the stitch during faster movement and automatically switches to constant for micro work and smaller stitches), baste, and constant speed.





Table Size and Spacing

The length of table you select will determine the maximum quilt width you can load onto your machine. The most important factors to consider when selecting a table size are the dimensions of your workspace and the size of the tops you plan to quilt. Gammill machines typically come with a 10 or 12-foot table. However, specialty sizes are available. A 12-foot table is our most popular size. With 122 to 123 inches of quilting space, this table will accommodate almost every quilt size. For comparison, a king-size quilt is approximately 100-inches wide.


